Board of Trustees Meeting, September 9, 2019

Present were Deb Spratt, Dick Bickford, Stephanie Cassidy, Paula Miller, and Charles Brault.

Review of the minutes from July 8, 2019, was read and approved.

The Treasurer's report was read and approved. Charlie said we maybe short for cleaning, but everything else is good. He is buying supplies from Special Account.

Circulation showed an upswing in July, as more people were using the library. Summer reading program had more people this year.

Dick asked if system was running OK. Charlie said he has remote access to the computers so if there is a problem he can fix it.

ILL (inter library loan) is about ready to come back on line. The board approved a baby changing station for \$211, from Special Account, and smocks to use for arts and crafts.
