Tel: (603) 878-1105 Email: cfpl\_green@hotmail.com Find us on Facebook What is a Student Library Card? Student library cards are available for non-Greenville residents over the age of 5 who attend school in the Mascenic Regional School District. These cards must be renewed each year.

How do I get a Student Library Card? Students must present a current student ID from a school in the Mascenic Regional School District. Students under age 18 must have a parent/guardian present to sign the library card application.

What types of material can I borrow? Student Library Card holders are able to borrow books, audiobooks, and magazines. These items are checked out for 2 weeks and may be renewed up to 2 times if no one else is on hold for the item. DVDs and Music CDs are not able to be borrowed with a Student Library Card. Downloadable ebooks and audiobooks can be borrowed at no cost from your town library.

The **Teen Fiction collection** includes audiobooks, manga, and graphic novels.

The **Children's Fiction collection** for middle readers includes audiobooks and graphic novels.

Our materials for young children include picture books, easy readers, board books, and puzzles.

The **Children's Non-fiction collection** has books for everyone from teens to young children.

The **Reference collection** contains noncirculating informational books for patrons of all ages.

Our **Magazine collection** covers every interest and includes magazines for children.

Remember, if we do not have what you are looking for, ask us! Our **Interlibrary Loan** system allows us to borrow items for you from other libraries.

#### Programs

The Chamberlin Library offers a variety of programs for patrons of all ages. Be sure to call, visit, or check our website for our full calendar of events. Some of our regular programs for children and teens are listed below.

**Kid Crafternoons:** Join us at 4:00pm on the 3rd Thursday of the month to make a fun craft in the library. We will provide all the materials, you bring the creativity! For children age 8-12.

**Teen Book Chat:** Join us at 3:30pm on the 1st Thursday of the month to chat about your latest reading fix! For teens age 12-17.

**Story Hour:** Join us at 10:00am each Thursday to listen to stories and make a craft. For children age 3-5. Runs September through May.

Each summer we offer a **Summer Reading Program** for children, teens, and adults.
